This year's event features guest speaker Kelvin J. Cochran, who is the U.S. Fire Administrator for the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), and is charged with overseeing, coordinating, and directing national efforts to prevent fires and improve fire response. Mr. Cochran has twenty – eight years of experience in the fire service to include Fire Chief for the City of Atlanta Fire Rescue Department.

Timothy E. Sendelbach is the President and Founder of TES², Training and Education Services. He is also currently the Editor-In-Chief of Fire Rescue Magazine. Mr. Sendelbach will be speaking on The Sofa Super Store Fire and about Fireground Leadership.

Dave Barr is a native Californian who rode his 1972 Harley-Davidson around the world. His journey carried him across six continents and took a grueling three and a half years (September 1990 - May 1994) and 83,000 ridden miles to complete. If this wasn't enough of a distinction, he's also the only disabled person to have accomplished such a feat. Dave is a double amputee, who lost both of his legs to a land mine explosion in Angola in 1981.

This year's event will be held at the Crowne Plaza Hotel, and holds exciting opportunities to interact with vendors and view state of the art fire service equipment. In addition to hearing the exceptional guest speakers and networking with vendors, come enjoy the scenic beauty of Colorado.

 - **Shopping in Manitou Springs:**

Hidden between Garden of the Gods and Pikes Peak, America's most famous mountain, lies the magical town of Manitou Springs. "Manitou," a Native American word for "spirit," describes this beautiful mountain community. Long before white men traveled here, the Ute, Cheyenne and many other natives considered this area sacred.
 - **Lunch in Garden of the Gods:**

Explore Colorado Springs' paradise in one magical stop. Garden of the Gods Park is a registered National Natural Landmark. Imagine dramatic views, 300' towering sandstone rock formations against a backdrop of snow-capped Pikes Peak and brilliant blue skies.
 - **Seven Falls:**

Located in a natural box canyon, it's the only waterfall in Colorado listed in the National Geographic list of International waterfalls. The one-mile drive winds along South Cheyenne Creek between steep cliffs covered with pines that at the narrowest are only 41 feet with interesting rock formations. The falls are best viewed from the Eagle's Nest Observation platform – accessed by the mountain elevator located inside the mountain. One can also take the 224-step stairway.
- Family Dinner Events: Includes dinner tickets to the Flying W Ranch on Wednesday night, Dinner at the Cheyenne Mountain Zoo on Thursday night, and lunch at the closing ceremony on Friday. \$65.00 per person.
