Gladstone Department of Public Safety, Fire/EMS Division is looking for a highly qualified individual to oversee the department's Emergency Medical Service and Quality Assurance Program. Gladstone DPS Fire/EMS Division personnel run nearly 3,000 EMS calls annually, which accounts for 87% of the Division's total call volume.

This position would serve as a liaison between the department and the ambulance service medical director(s). This individual will make ensure all EMS staff keeps informed on all advancements in pre-hospital healthcare through in-service instruction and advancement in medical protocols. This position will also make ensure that EMS protocol compliance by serving as the final review of each EMS report filed by field staff.

This position is responsible for coordinating with regional EMS training programs and preceptor programs for students seeking careers in emergency medicine. Other responsibilities include maintenance of EMS supply/inventory control and maintaining EMS records for the department. This position is appointed to the rank of Battalion Chief in the Fire/EMS Division and the ideal individual will have service of at least five years as a paramedic. This position is non-exempt (FLSA) and is normally scheduled to work Monday-Friday/40 hours each week. Candidates not possessing Missouri Firefighter I and II certification must be willing attend firefighting training and pass both written and practical examinations.

This position will report to the Fire/EMS Division Chief and the Director of Public Safety.
